The Collaborative Research Center 259 (TRR259) is a research network from the Universities of Bonn, Cologne, and Düsseldorf that is working on interrelated research projects in the areas of aortic disease. With this initiative, we aim to comprehensively address the underlying mechanisms of aortic disease, with a particular focus on aortic valve stenosis, aortic aneurysm, and aortic dissection. We envision identifying novel pharmacological, interventional, and surgical targets for diagnostic, preventive, and therapeutic strategies within the frame of translational and clinical studies.

While searching for new project ideas and techniques, we would like to attract motivated and talented female scientists for research on aortic diseases. That is why we would like to give PhD students and postdocs the opportunity to develop new project ideas to support the TRR259 in its research with a Postdoc Starting Grant for female scientists.

Fellowship for: late stage PhD-students or postdocs

Funding: Project-related consumables up to € 10,000 for 1 year

The application should include:

- Summary of the proposed project (max. 5 pages)
- Project description: Description of planned works, preliminary results (if available) timeline/milestones, an overview of estimated costs
- Collaboration partners
- A short CV of the applicant (if applicable, indicate family- or health-related career interruptions)
- A letter of support by the host laboratory (the applicant will have to be hosted in a lab/group at the University of Bonn, Cologne, or Düsseldorf)
